Ref: European RoHS Directive

On February 13, 2003, the European Union adopted Directive 2002/95/EC, known as the Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive (or RoHS), which restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

Implemented as of July 1, 2006, the RoHS Directive restricts the use of 6(six) substances in products and equipment sold in the European countries.

The 6(six) Hazardous Substances listed in this directive and their MAXIMUM allowable weight limits are:

LEAD ~ Pb	0.1%
MERCURY ~ HG	0.1%
CADIUM ~ Cd	0.01%
HEXAVALENT CHROMIUM ~ Cr(6+)	0.1%
POLYBROMINATED BIPHENYLS ~ PBB	0.1%
POLYBROMINATED DIPHENYL ETHERS ~ PBDE	0.1%

None of these substances are present in the materials sold by High Temp Metals, Inc. All of the materials supplied by HTM are compliant with the Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive.
